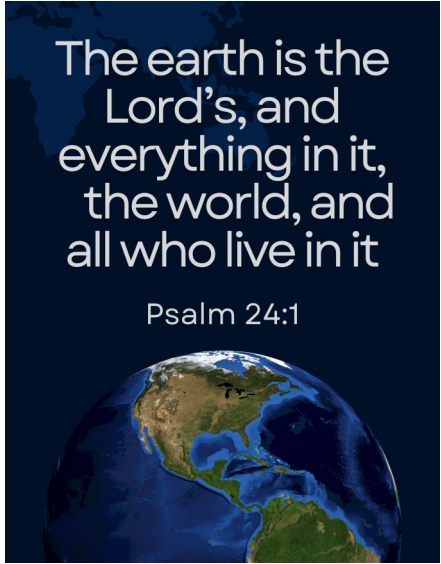

This morning we celebrate World Communion Sunday.

World Communion Sunday, celebrated on the first Sunday in October, is a Christian observance that promotes unity and cooperation among churches globally. On this day, congregations of various denominations come together to share in communion, symbolizing the shared belief in Christ's sacrifice and the unity of the global Christian community. The day highlights the interconnectedness of believers worldwide, fostering a sense of solidarity, peace, and hope through the common practice of the Lord's Supper.

Enrique Estrada, Managua, Nicaragua: Called to ministry in 1983, Enrique opened nine new mission fields and organized a church throughout his career. He served as a pastor for thirty years and an evangelist for five years for the Nicaraguan Institute of Evangelism. Enrique pursued three years of studies at the Bible Institute "MIZPA" and obtained a diploma in theology from the International Bible Institute. Additionally, he pursued a bachelor's degree in business administration, focusing on human resource management, and worked in this field for 23 years.

Eufemia del Socorro Cerda Peña, El Castillo, Nicaragua: Eufemia was trained as a Christian worker at the Nueva Jerusalem Church and Hosanna Church. She served as a church leader and led small groups until 2018. She graduated with a bachelor's degree in Psychology. Likewise, she also preaches, counsels, and teaches.

Enrique and Eufemia have five children, one of whom is Oscar David Cerda. Oscar, age 25, was born in Managua, Nicaragua. Currently employed at McDonald's, he enjoys playing football (soccer) in his free time.
