

This morning we welcome Rev. Mark Mahserjian-Smith. Mark earned his bachelor's degree from Eastern University in 1985 and a Master of Divinity from Eastern Baptist Theological Seminary in 1988. After graduating from seminary, Mark served as a local church pastor for nearly 20 years, spending five years at Emmanuel Baptist Church in Batavia, NY, and 15 years at Hepburn Baptist Church in Cogan Station, PA. He has been involved with ABCOPAD for 25 years, initially volunteering in 1999 with data entry while serving as the Pastor of Hepburn Baptist Church. In 2001, Mark became a part-time staff member focused on Technology and Communication, and in 2008, he was called to serve full-time as the Central Area Minister. When the Region adopted a new model for regional ministry in 2010, Mark became the Regional Pastor for Mission and Communication. In 2022. he was appointed Acting Co-Regional Executive Pastor, and in February 2024, he assumed the role of ABCOPAD Regional Executive Pastor. Mark has been married to his wife, Susan, for nearly 40 years, and they have been blessed with a large, blended family that includes multiracial and special needs children. His passion for U.S. and overseas mission work has taken him across the country and around the world, from New Jersey, Texas, and Puerto Rico to Mexico, Nicaragua, and Uganda. Mark states, "I am forever grateful to Jesus, who allowed me to become an adopted child in God's family through His death and resurrection."

Session 1: March 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6 p.m. in the Café Session 2: April 27<sup>th</sup> at 12 p.m., following the church service

Session 3: With special guest, Dr. David Gushee, May 18th at 9:45 a.m.

WHAT: We invite you to join Pastor Jeremy for a series of three sessions on what it means to be an inclusive church. The first session on March 23<sup>rd</sup> will serve as an introduction to why this topic matters. exploring the fruits of exclusion, defining key terms like "affirming" and "inclusion," and examining the church's history of changing its mind on important issues. Following this, we'll gather again on April 27th for a deeper dive into what the Bible says, and on May 18th we will have a special session with Dr. David Gushee, leading Baptist scholar in Christian Ethics. Professor of Christian Ethics at Mercer University. Chair of Christian Social Ethics at Vrije Universiteit in Amsterdam, NL, Senior Research Fellow at International Baptist Theological Study Centre. This series is not a political discussion, but a gospel and justice issue that is essential for Christians to address. Together, let's examine why inclusivity matters and how we can live out Christ's love more fully as an affirming community.
